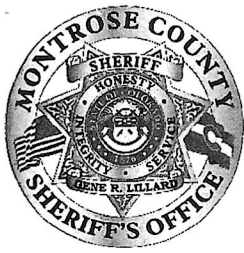

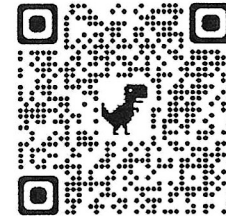

### READY OP's OBJECTIVES:

- Fast communications allow the sheriff's office to put out information efficiently. (i.e. suspects of major crimes, natural disasters, missing person, etc.)
- This is done through the organization within the program itself. People can be tagged in multiple groups, organizations, locations and filtered for communication accordingly.

- \* Subdivision/Group
- \* Admin
- \* SWAT
- \* Posse
- \* Patrol

### SECURITY MEASURES:

- Databases are fully encrypted and firewalled per log-in. (i.e., if you are apart of multiple groups within **ReadyOp**, the Montrose County Neighborhood Watch credentials only allow access to people's contact information tagged within Neighborhood Watch).
- **Self-Registration information** is automatically uploaded and secure within the Montrose County Sheriff's Office **ReadyOp** database.

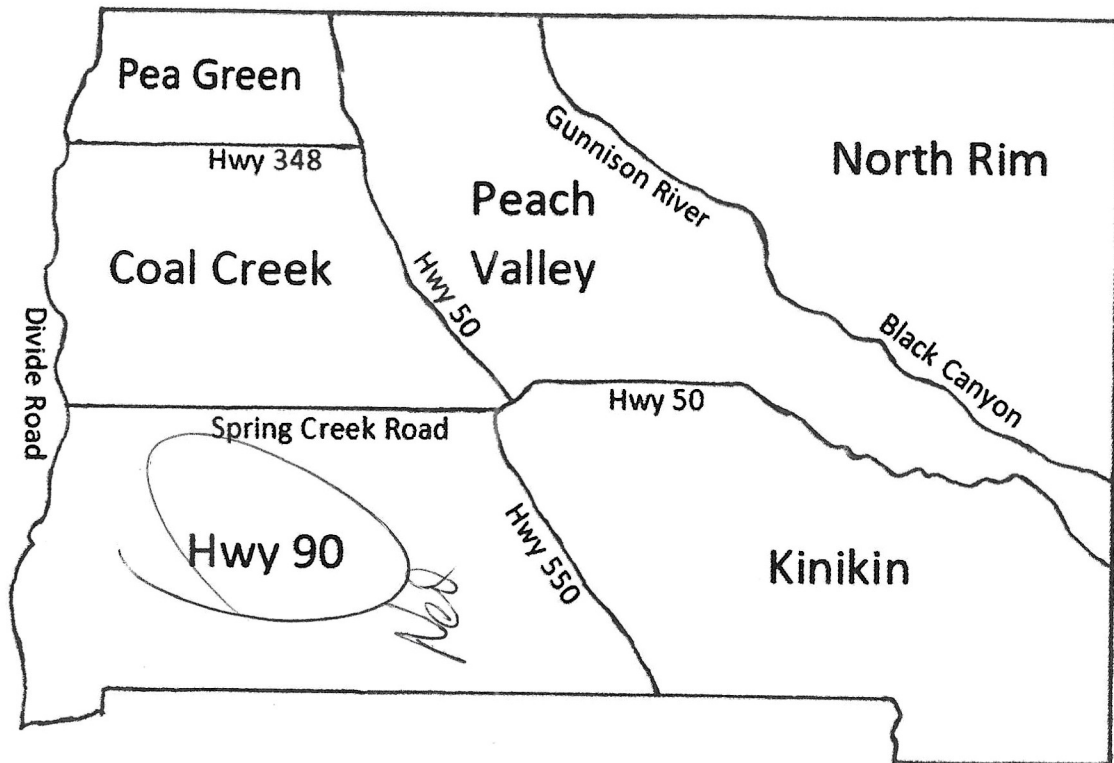

**Zone Map does not depict your subdivision – Please Indicate BOTH if applicable:**

- **Pea Green:** Any address numbered 0000-5999 within Montrose County, West of Hwy. 50, and East of Divide Road.
- **Coal Creek:** Any address numbered 6000-14999 within Montrose County, West of Hwy. 50, and East of Divide Road.
- **Hwy. 90:** Any address numbered 15000 to the southern county line which is located East of Transfer Road and West of Hwy. 550 / Townsend Avenue.
- **Peach Valley:** Any address located Northeast of Hwy 50 and Southwest of the Black Canyon.
- **North Rim:** Any address located within Montrose County located northeast of the Black Canyon.
- **Kinikin:** Any address within Montrose County located South of Hwy 50 and East of Hwy 550 / Townsend Avenue.
- **West End:** If you are a resident of Montrose County West of Divide Road please use the township of our mailing address. (i.e., Bedrock, Paradox, Nucla, Naturita, etc.)
